Instagram is a fun way to share your life with friends through a series of pictures. Snap a photo with your mobile phone, then upload it to **Instagram**. This is a free app available at the Apple Store and Google Play store. If you are "public" on **Instagram**, anyone can subscribe to follow your photos. If you are "private" on **Instagram**, the user can make sure he/she must approve all follow requests before they go through. We will be using **Instagram** this week at camp to post pictures of **anything related to camp**.

This is OPTIONAL, and not required.

How does it work?

All students will be allowed to take pictures of things they are doing at camp this week. Students can post their pictures with the hashtags "#enigma" and "#aigcamp2017". Students can then view all pictures with this hashtag, add comments, and "like" their favorite pictures.

AIG Camp also has an **Instagram**--"ecugifted"--for parents and campers to follow. Parents can check in throughout the day to see the exciting things going on at AIG Camp, and can also search "enigma" and "#aigcamp2017" to view all camp pictures.

What are the rules?

Students must post only pictures about AIG Camp on this **Instagram** during camp. We want pictures of what you are doing in camp while you are at camp, BUT picture taking can not get in the way of learning. Please be respectful of all teachers and do not let picture taking interrupt your learning. **All comments must be positive. Any inappropriate pictures and/or comments will be reported to Instagram as well as parents.** AIG Master Teachers will be closely monitoring all posts on **Instagram** during the week of camp.
